



RESPONSIBLE TAILGATING

Policy Statement: It is the Policy of Texas Tech University System to encourage safe and responsible socializing from students, alumni and fans who attend TTU Athletic events.

Game day parking and tailgating is a key component of the game day atmosphere. Your help is needed to ensure that donor-based Red Raider Club parking is a positive experience for everyone. We advise you to arrive early and invite you to enjoy the game day experience at the Red Raider Club Pre-Game buffet (located in the Athletic Training Center) and Raider Alley prior to each home game this season.

TAILGATING RULES AND REGULATIONS

Individuals are responsible for compliance with all local and state laws governing alcohol consumption.

All sidewalks, driveways and parking lot driving lanes must be kept clear for safety reasons. Do not tailgate or stand out into the driving lanes. All tailgating items should be kept within donor's assigned or allotted space(s). These items include cookers, vehicles, tents, lawn-chairs, coolers and overflow etc.

Only one space is permitted per parking pass; parking passes must be visible at all times.

Site setup may begin no earlier than 5:30 p.m. on the day immediately preceding any NCAA recognized campus sporting event.

Texas Tech University is not responsible or liable for accidents, damage, loss or theft of materials/items/personal property left overnight.

Delineating perimeters ("staking ground") for tailgating sites is prohibited. Chaining and/or roping off of tailgating spaces, items, and/or equipment to reserve your space is prohibited. No drilling or staking into the parking surface, for example to anchor a tent. Any person damaging University property will be responsible for cost of repairs.

Sound amplification equipment is prohibited.

Tents or canopies must be secured and may not obstruct sidewalks, driving lanes or pedestrian walkways.

BBQ grills must be attended at all times. Hot coals must be doused and properly disposed of to prevent fires. Fires built on the ground and open fire pit devices are prohibited.

Use of motorized recreational vehicles, including four-wheelers, golf carts, mules, gators, scooters, motorized skateboards, etc. are prohibited unless pre-approved by Texas Tech Athletics.

Dispose of all trash in trash receptacles located in tailgating areas or pack it out. The disposal of grease, hot coals or hazardous materials onto the grounds or into storm drains is prohibited.

Commercial activity or solicitations are not allowed on campus. Vendor spaces are available through Red Raider Sports Properties, 806.744.6888.

No "drop-offs" of items or persons will be permitted in reserved parking lots.

Port-a-Potties provided by Texas Tech Athletics may not be relocated for any reason. No additional Port-a-Potties may be brought onto campus.

***NEW* BAR CODES**

Donors, we are excited to announce the addition of bar coding on all priority parking passes. This system will help us to protect your priority parking benefit and reduce parking pass fraud.

Have your parking pass displayed en route and as you arrive at Jones AT&T Stadium.

At designated lot entry point remove your parking hang tag for the parking attendant to scan.

After your parking pass is scanned, return your parking pass to your mirror for display.

If you exit a lot with the intent to return please make sure your parking pass is scanned out. If you leave without scanning your pass, re-entry may be denied.
